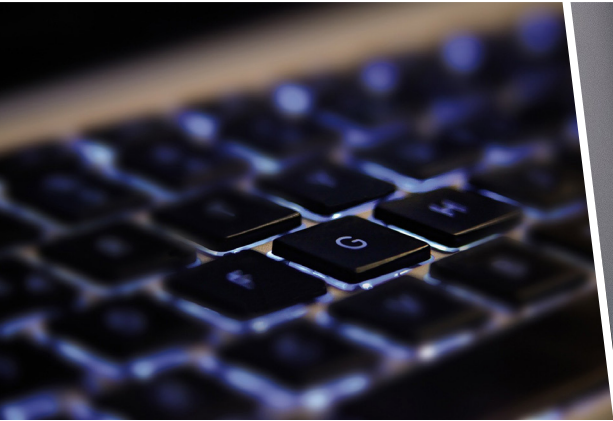

BSCpE: SOFTWARE ENGINEERING OPTION



GENERAL INFORMATION

Electrical and Computer Engineering plans to offer a Software Engineering Option (SOFT) as part of the Computer Engineering degree, effective fall 2021.

- The Option will require 12 credit hours of designated course work.
- The BSCpE degree currently has 6 credit hours of “Breadth Requirements” and 3 credit hours of “Controlled Electives”. The Option will use those 9 credit hours, thus eliminating all technical electives from the BSCpE degree.
- The Option adds an additional 3 credit hours to the BSCpE degree for a total degree program of 128 credit hours.
